**Between the University of Utah School of Medicine and the Morehouse School of Medicine**


This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understanding between the University of Utah School of Medicine and the Morehouse School of Medicine to participate in a cooperative relationship with each other on a goodwill basis.
